

Criteria for EECU's Glenn Mandeville Memorial Scholarship

EECU will present six \$5,000 scholarships to selected applicants within our field of membership. Three scholarships will be awarded to students intending to enter the field of education, and the other three scholarships will be given to students who are selecting careers outside the educational field. The scholarship committee will consider those students who meet the following eligibility requirements and proof of intent:

- Applicant must be a high school senior
- Applicant must be a member in good standing with EECU or parent/legal guardian must be a member in good standing with EECU
- Applicant must express on their application their intended course of study
- Recipient of scholarship funds must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.5 to receive annual distribution of funds
- The scholarship must be used for the purpose of study at an accredited college or university
- Academic achievement, character, leadership and personal recommendations will be considered in the selection of scholarship recipients
- **Applicant must include all required documentation and transcripts**

If selected as a finalist, the applicant may be required to participate in a personal interview.

Selections will be determined by a committee appointed by the Board of Directors of EECU.

If the committee's first choice does not accept the scholarship, an alternate candidate will be selected.

Upon evidence of enrollment, the first \$1,250 of the scholarship funds will be paid by EECU to the college/university where the recipient is enrolled. Further annual payments will be made upon proof of a minimum 2.5 GPA.
